SILVER PROGRAM

Top Driver's basic program provides 30 hours of interactive classroom instruction and 6 hours of in-vehicle training with certified driver education instructors. Our proprietary curriculum engages students with a rich mix of learning methodologies including DVD instruction, structured group discussions and individual exercises. Students "build their own training book" via response sheets corresponding to each lesson. Behind-the-wheel training features in-vehicle video training where an instructor can show a student a driving skill visually on a DVD player. The student can practice what they have seen and view it again if necessary. The Silver Program meets the state minimum requirements for a teen to get a driver's license.

GOLD PROGRAM

Top Driver's recommended program provides everything in the Silver Program plus 2 additional hours of customized in-vehicle training where we enhance specific skills. During these additional hours, the instructor will coach or challenge the student based on their skill level. For students competent in the basic skills, we focus on more advanced skills. For students needing additional training in a particular skill, we work with them to bring their skills to a competent level.

ADDITIONAL IN-VEHICLE TRAINING

Could you become proficient with a new language, hobby or sport in only a few hours with a coach? Of course not.
